H58/19 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs Button, Margrave, Sage, Shepherd and Short. Apologies were accepted.

H59/19 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest at the start of the meeting.

H60/19 PUBLIC FORUM

There was no public forum as they did not register to speak.

H61/19 MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 24th January 2019 as circulated were approved and signed as a true record.

H62/19 MATTERS ARISING OUT OF THOSE MINUTES

H55/19 – the soil that was at the entrance gate has been used for the mounds to deter traveller encampments on the playing field.

H63/19 OUTSTANDING PROJECT AND ACTIONS

Height restrictor at Washbourne Playing Field has been installed.

Asbestos Inspection done in February 2019 and report received.

Decision made to award the contract for the Millennium Garden refurbishment. Height restrictor at Acre Close – still only have one quote.

Dumped soil behind trees at Washbourne Playing Field – liaise with Kerry on available funding.

Tachbrook / Heathcote flower bed surround – Members proposed the brick option is approved as it will last longer than wooden surrounds.

Bark surrounds at Acre Close Playing Field – proposed the surrounds are replaced with treated timbers.

Asbestos re-inspection has been carried out. Report emailed to Cllr Barton. Structural survey due in May 2019.

Fixed wiring inspection and portable appliance due in May 2019. Gas inspection due in May 2019.
